


#### **E-QUIZ COMPETITION**




### NATIONAL WEBINAR - International Ozone Day - "Ozone For Life"


Total 23 students participated in the programme conducted by Kerala state biodiversity board on the eve of international day for biological diversity on 22<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.


# INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR - International Biodiversity Day - Biodiversity and Land Reclamation
