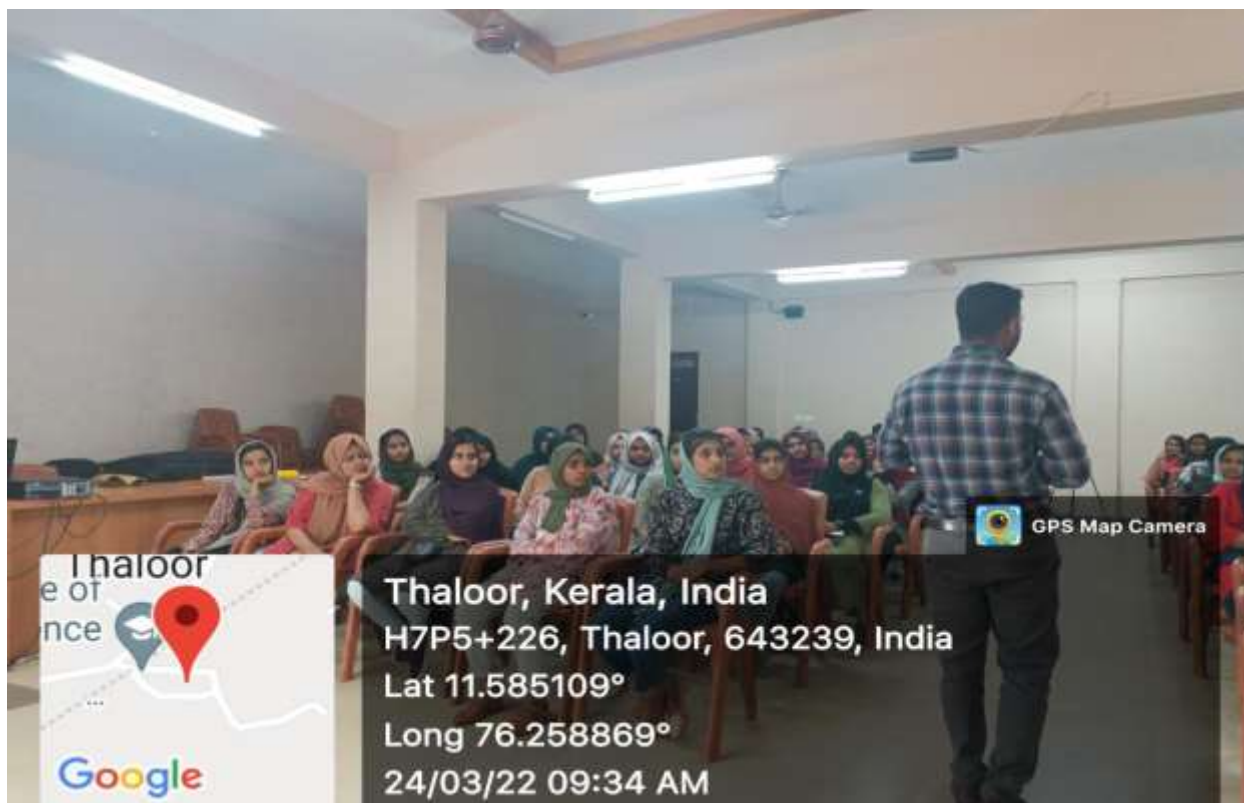

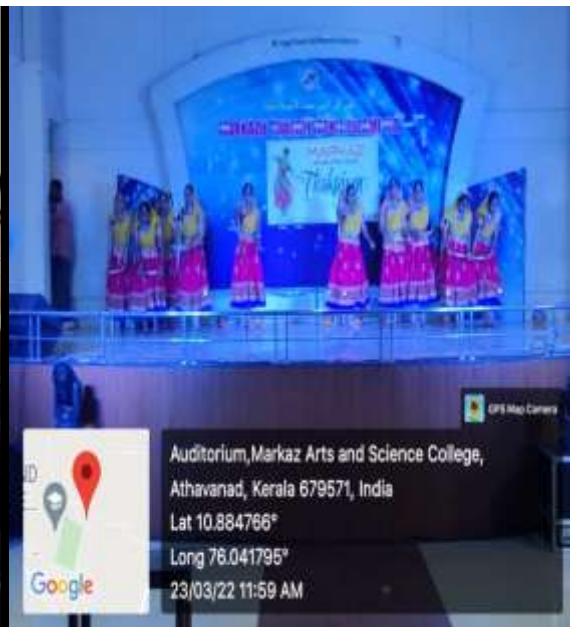

Women Development Cell

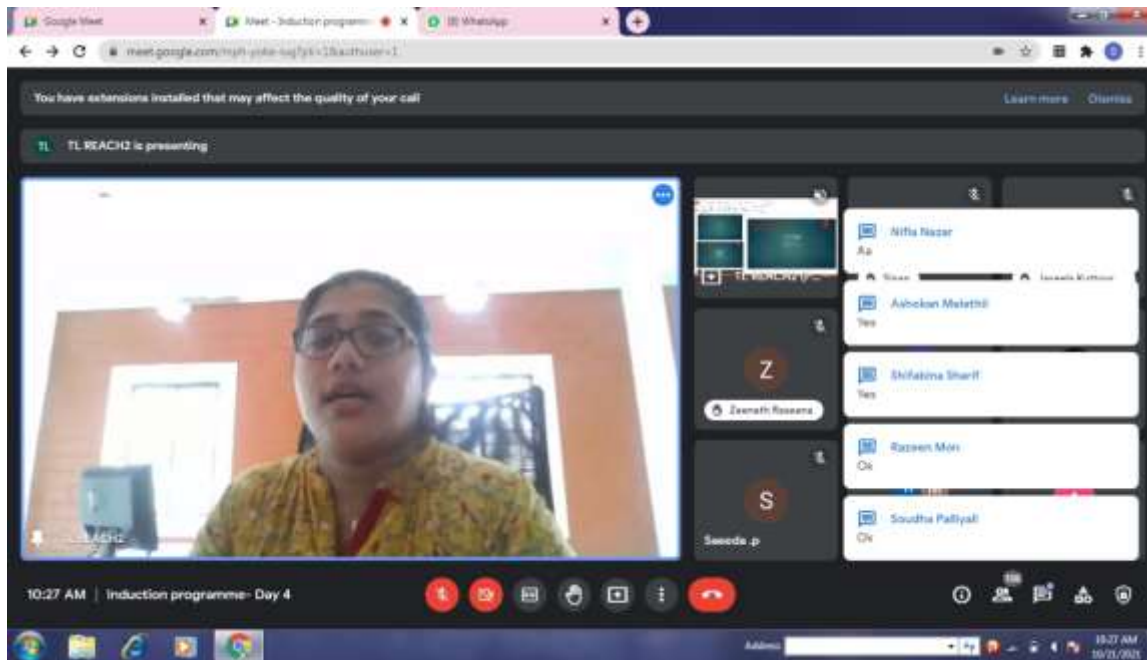
