

# Markaz Arts and Science College, Athavanad

## Annual Report 2024–25

MARKAZ ARTS AND SCIENCE COLLEGE ,ATHAVANAD affiliated to University of Calicut and recognized by Govt. of Kerala, was started in 2003 at Markaz campus as one of the most important educational missions of Markazu Tharbiyyathil Islamiyyah, a registered society with minority status. The college is offering both UG and PG programmes, envisages offering innovative and fruitful courses to lead the new generations to brighter future. The Markaz Arts and Science College aims at forming leaders of tomorrow who are intellectually competent, spiritually matured, psychologically strong, physically healthy and socially acceptable who will spread the message of love, truth, justice and peace in our society. The college is located at Karthala 5.5 kms away from Kuttippuram and 5kms from Valanchery. The doors of the institution are open to all students, irrespective of their caste and creed. The managing committee has got 30 acres available land at its disposal. The campus is an educational complex having 9 other educational institutions imparting education from KG level to PG level, a few with residential mod

The college was reopened on 03.06.2024 after summer vacation. There were 52 teaching and 12 non-teaching staff members during this academic year. There were a total of 557 degree and 114 post-graduate students on roll.

We subscribed 3 Journals and added 89 books to the library this year raising the number of books to 6239 and journal to 12. In addition there are two online journals, one in science and another one in commerce.
