COLLEGE GENERAL RULES

- I. The spirit of life in the college must be unity, mutual trust and co-operation between the students, staff and management.
- II. Students shall behave well-disciplined in and outside the campus.
- III. Every student must make it a point of his / her personal duty to attend the class daily and punctually. They are expected to be in the class at the first bell and wait for the teacher.
- IV. No student shall leave a class without the permission of the lecturer or until the class is dismissed.
- V. When teachers are forced to take leave and absent, students should remain in the class and do the work assigned to them for the period or go to the general library. No student should be seen outside the class room during class hours.
- VI. Students will not see visitors during the class hours. The students or those residing in hostels are not allowed to see their visitors in the college. Letters addressed to the college will not be delivered to the students. They will have their letters and communications addressed to their homes.
- VII. Students shall wear college uniform on all college days. In other occasions students are expected to dress modestly. Tights, mini skirt, flimsy clothes, short tops, sleeveless and deep neck lines will not be allowed.
- VIII. No matter of publication in the Newspaper, Magazine, Journals or Notice may be submitted in the name of the college without the permission of the Principal.
- XI. No meeting shall be held in the College building or anywhere in the college premises without the permission of the Principal
- X. Megaphone, Loudspeakers, Radio Camera etc. should not be used and notices, posters, banners or board shall not be displayed or distributed in the campus without permission.

- XI. Bringing & using of mobile phone, Lap, Tab etc. in and around the campus is strictly prohibited.
- XII. Students who use vehicles should keep the vehicle on the left side of the college.
- XIII. Loss or damage caused to building, furniture, tools and apparatus of the college due to violent action of students will be made good by imposing collective fine on all the students of the college.
- XIV. Keep the College furniture and other equipment of the college neat and in the serviceable condition. Do not disfigure wall or furniture with any writing and engraving. Any loss or destruction to college properties will be changeable individually or collectively as the case may be.
- XV. Students shall always carry identity cards with them.
- XVI. Student shall not participate in organizational activities of the student organizations directly or through their member students in the campus.
- XVII. Incidents of Ragging or any such indecent behaviour of any student to the fellow student involving physical or mental assault should be treated as a criminal offence, punishable under the provision of the Criminal procedure code. Hence students are warned from any act of vandalism being committed under the pretext of ragging and will not be tolerated at any cost. Those who indulge acts ignoring this warning should have to face drastic punishments including their summary dismissal from the rolls and even recommendation for police action. Students are strictly warned that there would be no warning in this matter and Court / University directions will be followed. Students shall not take part in activities against the authorities of the college.
- XIII. Students who do not abide by the rules will be seriously dealt with including removal from the rolls.
- XXI. Vehicles are not permitted into the campus. Those who bring with prior permission should keep it in the designated parking area.
