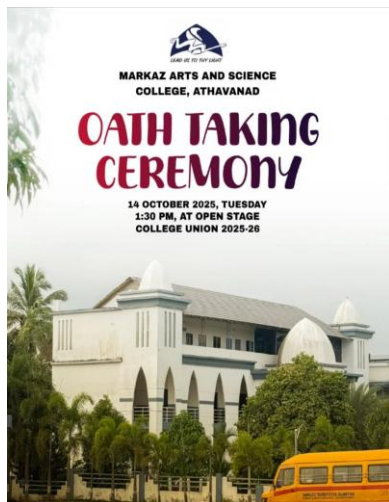

VICTORY DAY CELEBRATION

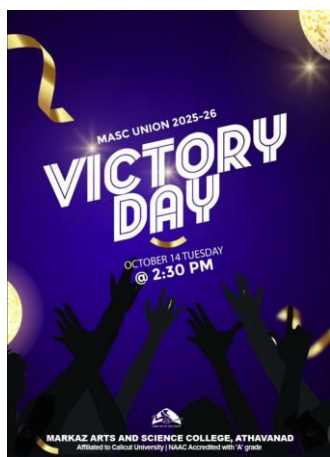

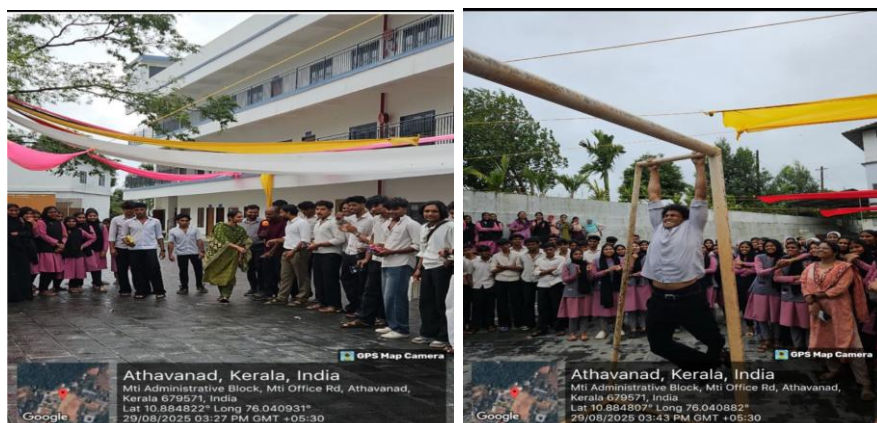
