In this auspicious occasion of 15th annual celebration of the college, I am placing a brief report of the club activities of the year 2020.

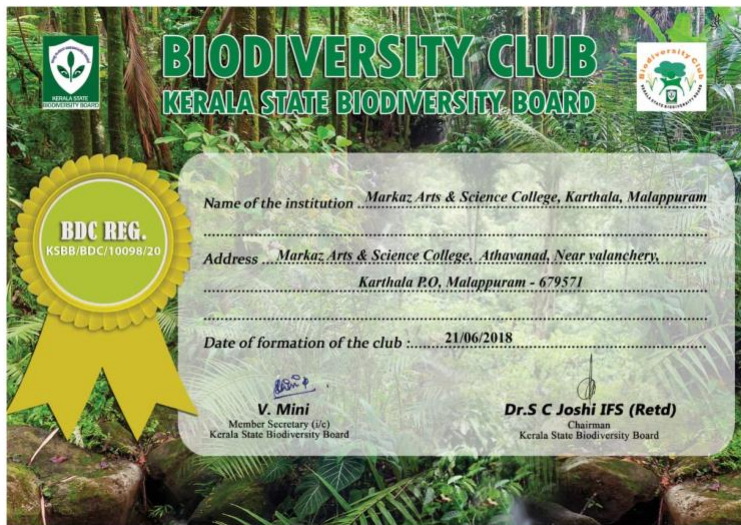

A major part of the work being:

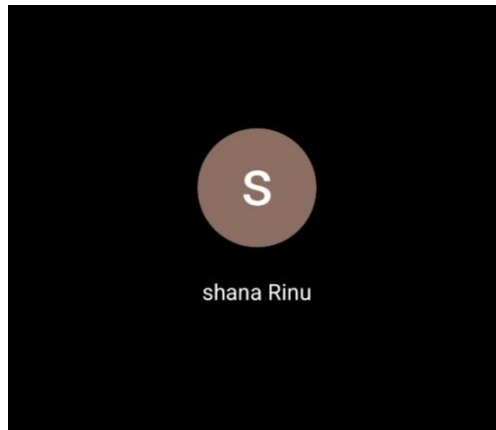
- Habitat improvement work
