MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN KOTTAKKAL FAROOK ARTS AND SCIENCE COLLEGE AND MARKAZ, ARTS, AND, SCIENCE, COLLEGGE, ATHAVANAD

- Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any information shared during the collaboration.
- The collaboration is subject to the laws and regulations of the respective governing bodies of the institutions.
- Either party may terminate this MOU by providing [number of days] days' written notice to
 the other party or immediately in the event of a material breach of any provision of this MOU
 by the other party.
- Upon termination or expiration of this MOU, both parties shall return any property, documents, or materials belonging to the other party that are in their possession.
- 5. The termination of this MOU shall not relieve either party from any obligations or liabilities that have accrued before the effective date of termination.
