#### ANNUAL REPORT OF DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY,

#### MARKAZ ARTS AND SCIENCE COLLEGE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 - 2021

In this auspicious occasion of 6th annual celebration of the department of psychology, I am privileged and honored to place the annual report of the activities of the year 2020 - 21.

The college reopened after summer vacation on 1/06/2020.

#### **STAFF AND STUDENTS:**

The department has 80 students on roll of which 23 are third year degree students, 26 are second year degree students and 30 are first year degree students. We have 2 full time faculty members and 1 part time teaching staff member for odd semester. Mr. Muhammad Sahid. K.P is Head of the Department. Ms. Fathimath Suhara has nominated as Department Secretary. Mr. Abdul Latheef K.A is part time faculty. We have three full time faculties for even semester. Mr. Abdul Latheef K.A appointed as Head of the Department of Psychology, Ms. Dhanya has nominated as staff coordinator of Department Association and Ms.Fathimath Suhara has nominated as Department Secretary.

First semester class for first year students started on 4th November 2020. Incubation programme was conducted for freshers by the department followed by one week bridge course. List of advanced learners and slow learners were created on the basis of bridge course examination marks obtained by students.

#### **CLASS PTA - MEETINGS**

- Parent Teacher meeting for 3rd semester psychology students were conducted on 9th September, 2020 via google meet. The principal of the college, head of the department, other teaching staffs and 24 parents had attended the meeting; and had a discussion on first internal examination marks, student's attendance report and new teaching - learning methods.
- An online Parent Teacher meeting was conducted for fifth semester psychology students on 15th September, 2020. The principal of the college, head of the department, other

teaching staffs and 20 parents had attended the meeting; and had a discussion on first internal examination marks, student's attendance reports and new teaching - learning methods.

- Department of psychology was conducted parent teacher meeting for first semester students at Markaz Arts and Science College on 9th December, 2020. P. Muhammad Kutty gave detailed talk on the rules and regulations to be followed in the college, internal mark structure and other important aspects.

#### **ONE DAY WEBINAR**


**Topic**: How social media ruining young minds


#### THEME VIDEO PRESENTATION

2020. The videos were published through the official Instagram account and You Tube channel of the college. The aim of the video presentation was to provide insight about suicide prevention.


#### POSTER MAKING CONTEST



World Suicide Prevention Day is an awareness day observed on 10 September every year, in order to provide worldwide commitment and action to prevent suicides, with various activities around the world since 2003.On behalf of this day Department of Psychology & Internal Quality Assurance Cell in collaboration with Listening Community & Sisters Living Works Inc. Organized a one day national webinar on the topic Working Together To Prevent Suicide Prevention on 14th September 2020 via Google meet. The



webinar was organized by Mr. Abdul Latheef (Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology).

The aim of the webinar was to provide a insight on

- How to prevent suicide
- Who can prevent suicide
- Conditions to prevent suicide

The webinar started at 10 am in the morning via Google meet. It was an 3 hr session. Around 200 people participated in this webinar. And it was divided into two different sessions handled by two excellent speakers. The programme started with a welcome speech delivered by Mr. Abdul Latheef (Assistant professor Psychology Department). Mr. Mohammed Sahid.K.P (HOD Of Psychology Department) delivered the Presidential Address and Ms.Fathimath Suhara (Assistant Professor Psychology Department) given a Theme Presentation on World Suicide Prevention Day. The webinar was inaugurated by Dr.C.P Muhammad Kutty (Principal of Markaz Arts and Science College, Athavanad). People from all over the Nation

participated in this programme. UG/PG students, scholars, researchers, psychologists from New Delhi, Assam, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal also participated in it. The first session of the webinar was handled by **Ms.Ketki Sanghavi** (Child Rights, Menstrual Hygiene and Suicide Prevention Professional, Mumbai) dealing with the topic "Students role in suicide prevention". The second session was handled by Mr.Abdul Gafoor (Clinical Psychologist, Research Scholar Jamia Millia Central University, New Delhi) dealing with the topic "Lets lend our ears". He told about how Active listening plays an important role in individuals' life? He also said that it demonstrates sincerity, and that nothing is being assumed or being taken for granted. Listening is a medium of gaining or exchanging information and knowledge, it helps you achieve your goals and getting things done. It helps building trust and credibility; it is a good supportive activity that people appreciate especially when they are upset or otherwise concerned. He concluded that active Listening is a tool for effective communication leading to healthier relationships that result in emotional security which could help in overcoming isolation. Participants in the webinar were provided with a feedback form. All participants had very positive response about the webinar. The session ended at 1.30 pm by delivering a Vote of thanks by the student coordinator Ms. Hana Basheer.




#### CENTRE FOR COUNSELLING AND PSYCHOSOCIAL SUPPORT

### SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES


